As the Sanctuary Advisory Council Coordinator, she serves as the primary contact for the Advisory Council and facilitates all aspects of council-related activities. Leslie also assisted with the sanctuary expansion review process. Leslie began diving in the sanctuary in the 1990s, as a volunteer fish surveyor, while working for the state of Texas as an Aquatic Scientist. After moving to the Florida Keys, she returned occasionally to FGBNMS to lead and instruct groups of REEF (Reef Environmental Education Foundation) divers and conduct fish assemblage surveys. Leslie returned to Galveston in 2012.

Leslie's presentation will focus on Flower Garden Banks National Marine Sanctuary and its recent expansion of 14 additional banks and reefs in the Gulf of Mexico.

Volunteering at Moody Gardens



Hello! Everyone, I hope all is well with all my Lunarfins family.

I have had some members ask about volunteering at the aquarium and actually right now they have changed the volunteer interviews to a one-on-one basis instead of the spring and fall recruitment process. Karl Maas is the volunteer coordinator and he told me that he would be happy to schedule one on one meetings with people that are looking to volunteer at this time. Jake And the heads of the dive team are still working on how to deal with the Covid and volunteers in the dive program, as there are share the air in an emergency and in training and buddy issues as people are in extremely close proximity without masks of the dry earth kind.

But behind the scenes working with the Curators and the Biologists or in front of the scenes working with the public as a naturalist (educator) right now is a really big need and as the intern's head back to school and college there's going to be a greater need for help.

Behind the scenes you do some cleaning, food prep, feeding, more cleaning, etc. It might sound kind of mundane but as I have been there, I have learned a lot about mother nature and her children. a lot about their care what they eat how they live how they act. I can honestly say I have gotten an awesome education in the past couple of years in exchange for a little labor. Typically, everything is scheduled in four-hour shifts, right now Karl is good with adjusting the shifts as folks need. I prefer to do a full eight-hour day as midday traffic going to Moody Gardens on 61st St. can be a nightmare. My goal is to eventually make the dive team but even when that happens I will still do my time behind the scenes as I enjoy what I do very much. The December of 2019 I actually got to help feed the coral in the bio lab for the coral replenishment project. The goal is to help replace the hard corals that are dying off in the coral reefs, they can't stop the die off so they have decided to grow more corals in controlled environments to suit each area particular needs to replenish what we're losing. Right now, I am in the jellies gallery and I have learned a lot about jellyfish and jellies because not all jellies are fish. Something I did not know until recently. The people at Moody are awesome a fter 50 hours of service you get a season pass and discounts on season passes for up to five family members for \$50 each for the year, you get discounts on food, Merchandise, Services and rooms at the Moody Gardens Hotel. I did not know this when I volunteered, I was there to work towards being a diver and work with the fish and the animals. So it was kind of sweet to find out that there were all these perks.

By the way we do have some members that are already divers their PJ Campagna, Shon Corrier, and Barbara Corbin are there. PJ is the one that got me started there. Hopefully I will be back in the water on the 27th of this month so everybody will be hearing more from me as Kim Murphy, Jim Carmin and I start getting back in the water and doing some diving I really miss it.
