Autumn Blum is a cosmetic chemist, entrepreneur, and lifelong ocean advocate. After successfully launching and selling her first skincare startup to a publicly traded company, Autumn dove deeper into her mission – founding Stream2Sea, offering the first and only mineral sunscreens on the market that are tested and proven safe for freshwater fish, saltwater fish, c. elegans, and coral larvae.

With a B.Sc. in Chemistry and Environmental Geology from Eckerd College, Autumn has spent nearly 30 years creating high-performance, eco-conscious personal care products. She was Inducted as a member the Women Divers Hall of Fame in 2022, she has presented to the National Academies of Science, testified before the U.S. Senate, and played a key role in legislative efforts to ban toxic ingredients in Hawaii, the Florida Keys, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and beyond. She currently serves on the Board of Advisors for Reef Renewal USA and is an active member of the Society of Cosmetic Chemists, the American Botanical Council, and is a Trustee for the Women Divers Hall of Fame.

Autumn's unwavering commitment to the triple bottom line—people, planet, and profit—has defined her career. The idea for Stream2Sea was sparked during a liveaboard dive trip, where she witnessed firsthand the toxic trail left by conventional sunscreens. As a formulator, she knew: We can do better. Today, she leads the charge for safer, science-backed alternatives and empowers others to create big impacts through small, conscious choices to protect our blue planet. 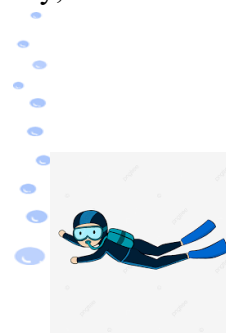
On a final note, I say farewell to someone who I consider a legend in the dive community; he will be missed. I will see you on the other side, Pee Wee.

Dennis Deavenport

Dennis Deavenport is at Perito Moreno Glacier National Park, Patagonia Argentina.

April 1 — On our last day in Patagonia, Perry and I toured the massive Perito Moreno glacier which covers nearly 100 sq mi of the Patagonia Ice Field in Chile and Argentina. The day was beautiful but I was coming down with a bad head cold that stayed with me for nearly three weeks. The scenery kept me going and after a punishing long walk up and down stairs viewing the glacier as it was busily calving icebergs into the headwaters of Lake Argentina, we made it back to El Calafate. We went to a high end restaurant that evening and I ordered a Guanaco loin dish. Guanaco, a Llama cousin, must be an acquired taste. That's the last camel I'll ever eat. It looked great though and we enjoyed talking with a mother and daughter about our Antarctica adventure. Then it was time to fly home, return to IAH to retrieve my lost backpack, and crawl into my bed for 4 days to recuperate. All is well now. Feeling great again. What an unusual adventure.





Rodney Paul Dwire, affectionately known as “PeeWee,” was born on January 2, 1947, in the small town of Ben Wheeler, Texas, in a farmhouse near Tyler. On the day he entered the world, he was given the nickname “PeeWee.” He passed away on April 5th, which was Easter Sunday. PeeWee was the proud father of two children: his son, Jack Dwire, and his daughter, Wendy. Sadly, Wendy passed away in 2017.

PeeWee’s journey into scuba diving began in October 1978, when his brother-in-law, Leonard Davis, introduced him to the ocean—a time when scuba gear was primarily black and used mostly by men. He became a certified diver, joined AquaMasters, and later became involved with Diehard Divers of Houston, Texas. PeeWee served as President of Diehard Divers and was also the Editor of their newsletter. When Diehard Divers merged with the Pasadena Underwater Divers Club in Pasadena, Texas, PeeWee continued his commitment. Upon the club’s dissolution, its treasury funds were donated to DAN (Divers Alert Network), a small but impactful organization that would grow to become the gold standard in the diving community.

In 1980, PeeWee became a member of Bay Area Divers (BAD), remaining active for 32 years and serving six terms on the board. He chaired the Spearfishing Rodeo for BAD in 2001. In 1996, PeeWee joined the Houston Underwater Club, where he was a member for eight years. He also joined Lunarfins Scuba Club in 2012, inspired by his girlfriend Ja Van Pruett, who had been a member for 14 years. PeeWee sat on the Lunarfins board as an Advisor. PeeWee was known for working behind the scenes and was always someone you could rely on for help. Among his favorite dive locations were anywhere in the Gulf of Mexico, offshore rigs, and CoCo View.

Before retiring in 2012, PeeWee regularly volunteered at the BAD Flea Market, sometimes known as the BAD Expo and Market. He helped with unloading and reloading vendor inventory and lent a hand wherever he needed throughout every year’s event.

PeeWee was also an individual member of the Texas Gulf Coast Council (TGCC) and served on its Board beginning in 1980. He served as 1st Vice President from 2017 to present. He was always ready to volunteer and never shied away from any task that needed to be accomplished. He had been active for 48 years of diving and volunteering.

- Also served on the board of ACWAF 2023–2026

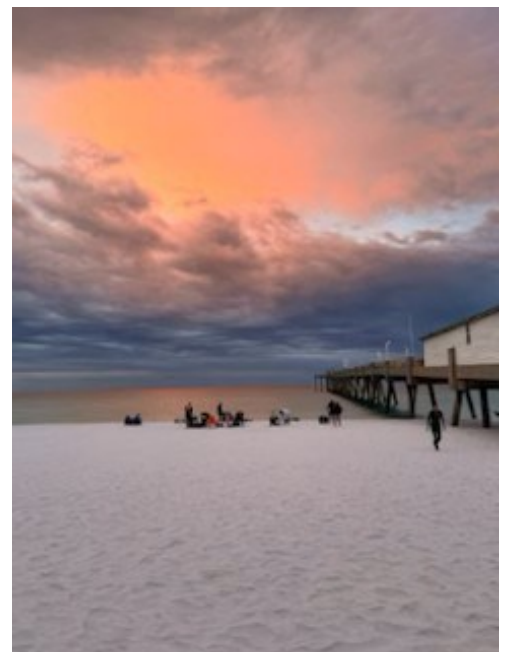

PeeWee enjoyed a long-term loving relationship with Ja Van Pruett for 25 years and they finally “tied the knot” on December 7th 2025, at the Lunarfins Christmas Party surrounded by friends and family. PeeWee survived 4 rounds of chemotherapy and then surgery on December 8th of 2025, for Cancer of the Esophagus and continued to fight for survival until his passing only a few weeks ago. May his memory, his dedication, kindness and passion to help the diving community inspire all of us. PeeWee will remain alive in our hearts. May his memory be a blessing to all that knew him.
